Service Information

Patient Eligibility

- Patients of ≥18 registered with a GP in Frimley ICB
- Signs and symptoms of cataract identified at sight test and patient would like to be considered for cataract surgery

Source of Referral/Signposting to Service

- Self-presentation
- Intra- Practice Referral

Service Delivery

- Assessment of vision and refraction
- Discussion of risks and benefits of surgery
- Clinical assessment of anterior and posterior eye
- Where patient wants referral, confirm this meets ICB policy and offer patient choice of appropriate surgical providers.

Service Outcomes

- Direct referral to patient's chosen surgical provider
- Discharge from service as patient does not want or need cataract referral at this time.
