Diabetes	Most patients will already be under the DES /DRSS for diabetic retinopathy screening. If a diabetic patient is not being screened, please refer them to their GP with a request for 'retinopathy screening' (not an ophthalmology referral).
Dry eye	Please only refer patients with dry eye, blepharitis, chalazion, stye and epiphora after six weeks of basic treatment (e.g. lid hygiene, warm compresses, lubricants etc) has failed to alleviate their symptoms.
Suspect wet AMD	Patients can be referred using the wet AMD rapid access referral form (available from the wet AMD section of our website) if they have a visual acuity of 6/96 or better in the affected eye, and symptoms of:
	 visual loss; or spontaneously reported distortion; or onset of scotoma (or blurred spot) in central vision
