A Note for Contractors and Practice Managers Ensure that all optometrists in your practice, including locums, have clinical access to Cinapsis from their start date. When enrolling a new optometrist as a PCSE user, remember to grant them Cinapsis clinical access at the same time.

Additionally, you can grant registered dispensing opticians and contact lens fitters access to make referrals within their scope of practice.

BMEC Emergency Eye Clinic Referrals via Cinapsis EeRS

BMEC now offers an "Emergency Referrals" option through Cinapsis, which should be your primary method for referring any genuine ophthalmic emergencies. The information you submit is sent directly to the Emergency Department, and patients are instructed to go immediately to the BMEC Emergency Department. Phone calls are only necessary if you are referring outside of working hours.



DICTATION – Cinapsis dictation is now live. Simply press on the microphone symbol to use the dictation service where it displays on your referral forms.

Can I print a Referral from Cinapsis? Yes. The best way to print a referral is to first download the referral by clicking the Download Case Report button (found in the top right-hand corner) of the referral. Once downloaded, you can open it as a PDF Document and download it from there.
